COOKIES POLICY

Evalanch Ltd (the "Company" or "TenTrade" or "us", "we", or "our") uses cookies on https://tentrade.com (the "Service"). By using the Service, you consent to the use of cookies.

Our Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third parties we may partner with may use cookies on the Service, your choices regarding cookies and further information about cookies.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of text sent by your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the Service or a third-party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the Service more useful to you. Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies.

2. How we use cookies?

When you use and access the Service, we may place several cookie files in your web browser.

We use cookies for the following purposes: to enable certain functions of the Service, to provide analytics, to store your preferences, to enable advertisements delivery, including behavioural advertising. We use both session and persistent cookies on the Service, and we use different types of cookies to run the Service.

Cookies are frequently used on many websites on the internet, and you can choose if and how a cookie will be accepted by changing your preferences and options in your browser. Some of our business partners (i.e., advertisers) use cookies on our websites). We have no access to, or control over, these cookies.

The cookies do not contain personally identifying information nor are they used to identify you. You may choose to disable the cookies. However, you may not be able to access some parts of our websites if you choose to disable the cookie acceptance in your browser, particularly the secure parts of the Website.

3. Essential cookies

We may use essential cookies to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts.



4. Persistent Cookies

We use persistent cookies for the following purposes:

- To help us recognise you as a unique visitor (a number) when you return to our website and to allow us to tailor content or advertisements to match your preferred interests or to avoid showing you the same adverts repeatedly.
- To compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how users use our site and to help us improve the structure of our website.
- To internally identify you by account name, name, email address, customer ID, currency, and location (geographic and computer ID/IP address)
- To differentiate users who are on the same network to enable us to correctly allocate transactions to the appropriate account.
- Within research surveys to ensure you are not invited to complete a questionnaire too often or after you have already done so.

5. Third-party cookies

In addition to our own cookies, we may also use various third parties' cookies to report usage statistics of the Service, deliver advertisements on and through the Service, and so on.

6. What are your choices regarding cookies? How to delete and block cookies?

If you'd like to delete cookies or instruct your web browser to delete or refuse cookies, please visit the help pages of your web browser. Please note, however, that if you delete cookies or refuse to accept them, you might not be able to use all the features we offer, you may not be able to store your preferences, and some of our pages might not display properly.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer.
